Duties and Responsibilities of the Computer Literacy Teacher

1. The learning Environment:

The Computer Literacy Teacher shall:

- Make sure the computer laboratory is a dynamic, welcoming and safe learning environment at all times;
- Clean and perform preventive maintenance on hardware, software and other peripheral equipment and materials to ensure they are in good working condition;
- Make backups, and restore files in the event of a malfunction;
- Maintain an inventory of equipment and supplies, and records of software licenses and other records
- Maintain a log of hardware and software problems and make follow up in a timely manner.
- Troubleshoot computer malfunctions as necessary
- Prepare an annual computer lab order that includes appropriate software, replacement parts and other materials, in consultation with the Programme Director

2. Teaching and Learning:

The Computer Literacy Teacher shall

- Plan instruction that is consistent with the mission, core values and standards of the school.
- Design learning objectives and activities to increase students' knowledge and understanding of basic computer operations and usage.
- Engage students through hands-on experiences that reinforce the fun of learning and enables struggling students to thrive.
- Coordinate and collaborate with class teachers to integrate areas of the curriculum in the computer laboratory lessons.
- Provide students with hands-on practice sessions and experiences to enable them build their knowledge, skills and competencies in basic computer technology and usage
- Monitor activities and behaviour of students to ensure their safety, as well as adherence to appropriate conduct in the computer laboratory.
- Develop schedules in collaboration with classroom teachers to ensure that all students and teachers have equitable access to and support in computer laboratory.
- Monitor and assess students' performance towards learning objectives, and improve learning outcomes.
- Help teachers at different competency levels to improve their ability to use computer technology for themselves and their students.
- Respond adequately, and in a timely manner, to technical questions from teachers and students.

3. As Member of the PAMBE Ghana La'angum School:

The Computer Literacy Teacher shall

- Actively participate in school, community, and cultural activities including parent/teacher conferences and orientations, staff meetings, curriculum development and extra or co-curricular activities.
- Consistently apply policies in the school, including classroom management, health and safety, and equal opportunities policies.
- Promote and maintain the highest standards in all aspects of work in the school.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- DBE, teaching certificate or HND from an accredited educational institution.
- At least two-years teaching experience at the basic school level

- Communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing
